## Preparing for Winter Weather: CANCELLATIONS AND DELAYS

When inclement weather causes the closing of school, the following procedures will be followed:

**School Closing:** Announcements will be made via the following radio (1340AM, 104FM, 95FM, and 570AM) and the television stations (Channel 2, 5, 6, 11, and 26) by 5:30 a.m. that school will not be in session. We will also utilize the School Messenger Announcement calling system.

**Late Starts:** When weather conditions warrant, the start of school may be delayed either one or two hours. Such an announcement will be made on the radio. Buses will run one or two hours late. The GSRP AM students would not attend.

**Early Dismissal:** Our office will be notified of early dismissals due to bad weather as early as possible. Dismissal time from classes and bus schedules to transport children will be determined by the Superintendent. **Please remind your child what to do in case of an early dismissal. This information should also be on file with your child's teacher.**
